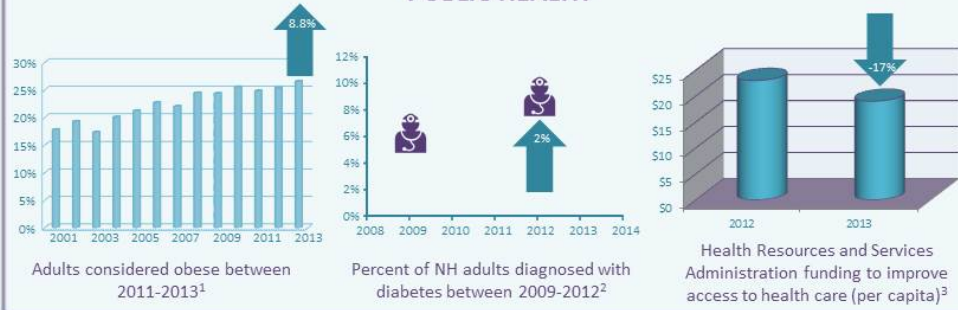


## ABOUT US

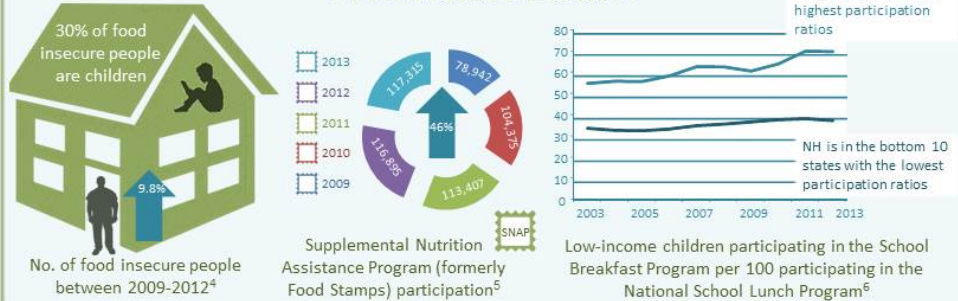

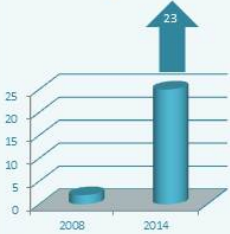

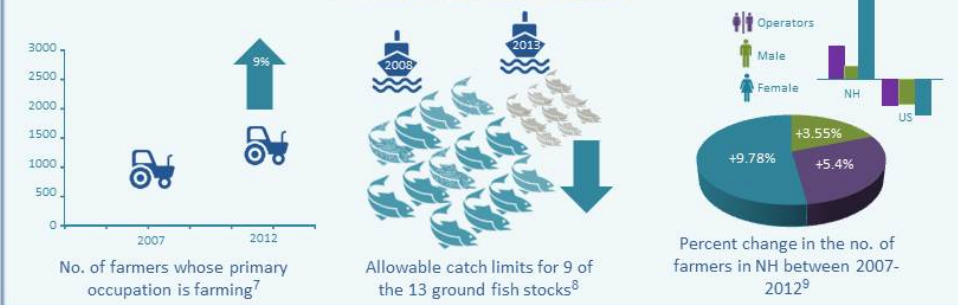
On August 8, 2014, Governor Hassan signed the Granite State Farm to Plate Program<sup>17</sup>



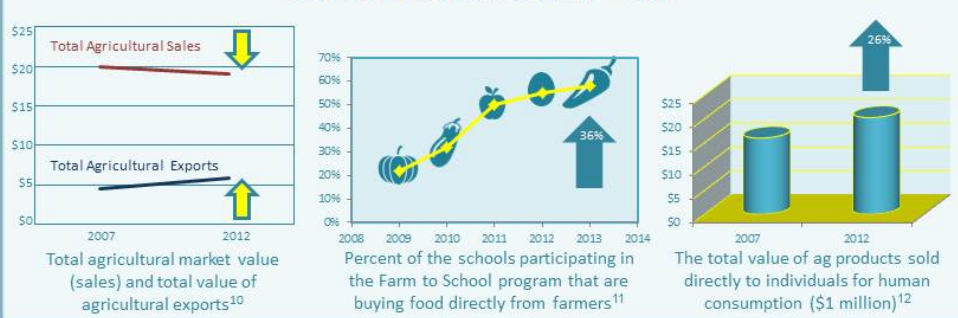
